ONLINE MARKING OF HOME ECONOMICS FOOD STUDIES ASSIGNMENT

As per the guidance provided in circular S71/23 on the continued rollout of the digital completion and submission of coursework, 2025 Leaving Certificate Home Economics candidates are currently completing their food studies assignment using digital booklets.

These will be submitted to the SEC using the Schools Portal from where they will be transferred to the online marking platform for marking.

- For the duration of the marking, you will require access to: a PC, or a laptop, with keyboard and mouse; an internet connection; and a Broadband speed of at least 2 MB.
- You will be provided with comprehensive training in using the software. Over the course of the marking, you will also have access to a help-desk to provide you with back-up and support.
- There is no need to have a high level of computer literacy, as the online marking software is easy to use, and suitable for everyone.

NOTES FOR THE INFORMATION OF APPLICANTS INCLUDING CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT

(Notes 2-10 are Conditions of Appointment)

- 1. This is a new application please read <u>all</u> the notes and complete form in full.
- 2. Appointment to the position of Examiner for the Leaving Certificate Home Economics (Scientific and Social) Digital Coursework Journals will be regarded as a contract for Service.

Examiners will be required to attend a two-day marking conference which will take place in:

Athlone on 28th November 2024 and online on 30th November 2024.

The completion date for the marking of Food Studies Practical – Digital Coursework Journal will be towards the end of January 2025.

- 3. Appointment as examiner in any given year does not confer the right to appointment in subsequent years.
- 4. Travelling expenses and subsistence allowances paid to an Examiner will be in accordance with Department of Finance regulations. All expenses paid to contract staff engaged on the 2025 examinations will be in accordance with published public service rates and will not be subject to any deductions. Applicants should note that the public service subsistence rates and qualifying distances changed with effect from 1st April 2017. Further information is available from the *Information for Contract Staff* Section of www.examinations.ie.
- 5. In line with the terms of the Public Service Stability Agreement, the SEC will be applying the relevant increases to contract staff remuneration in 2025.
- 6. All payments on foot of this appointment will be made through an electronic money transfer system (i.e. Paypath). We will collect your bank details at a later stage. It is not possible to arrange payment other than to a bank account, therefore acceptance of payment to a bank account is a condition of employment.
- 7. If you fail to comply fully with the SEC's Instructions or if you act in a way which jeopardises the security or integrity of the examinations or if you act in a way which jeopardises the performance of the candidates, you are liable to be dismissed and you may also be refused any

- future appointment. If you are dismissed, you shall have no claim whatsoever against the SEC for remuneration or expenses.
- 8. Applicants should note that all applications will be considered fairly and impartially by the State Examinations Commission. Applicants giving incorrect information will be disqualified. Canvassing will lead to the application being disqualified.
- 9. The following persons **are not** eligible for appointment or to undertake examining duties:
 - a) Teachers who have taken early retirement under Strand 1 of the Early Retirement Scheme for teachers.
 - b) Teachers who are on paid Statutory Maternity Leave at the time of Conferences or during the Examining period.
 - c) Teachers who are on paid/unpaid sick leave.
 - d) Teachers who are on Suspension/Administration Leave.
 - e) Teachers in receipt of disability pension.*
- *Applications from teachers in receipt of disability pension will be considered on receipt of a completed medical report form. This form is available on request from (090) 644 2862/2826 or in the Recruitment section of www.examinations.ie.
- 10. If subsequent to confirming acceptance of appointment you become unavailable, you should contact the SEC immediately by phone and confirm your unavailability by letter or e-mail. Likewise if, subsequent to applying or confirming acceptance of an appointment, you experience any change in circumstances (see note 9) which would render you ineligible for appointment you must notify the SEC immediately.
